

#### What Do You Pray for Leaders?

I've been thinking (yes, dangerous, I know). At CPAS we pray daily for church leaders: those we encounter through our leadership training, those who lead our Patronage churches (nearly 700 of them), those who lead our holidays for children and young people.

What should we be praying for them? And by extension what should we pray for ourselves as leaders?

A good place to start is the prayers we find in the Scriptures (for example, Ephesians 3:14-21). Then add in a healthy mix of **prayers for faith, hope and love** (1 Corinthians 13). But what else might we focus on as we pray specifically about leadership? Here are five things I'm praying for leaders at this time.

- **Integrity** Lord help leaders to live lives of integrity where who they are in public reflects who they are in private.
- **Compassion** Lord, grow compassion in leaders that they might be moved by their daily encounters with people to lovingly serve the needs of others.
- **Courage** Lord, embolden leaders to do what is right, Christ-honouring, and kingdom building, despite the cost.
- **Wisdom** Lord, give wisdom to leaders as they constantly face decisions where there isn't necessarily a right way forward, that they may discern the wise way forward.
- **Tenacity** Lord, grow perseverance and endurance in leaders that they might press on through the trials and hardships.

I wonder what your list of five things would be.

When you've identified your five, how about committing to pray them for leaders you know throughout March. And whilst you are doing that, why not pray them for yourself as well.
